



THE “LYNTON INCOLL” UK CONFERENCE BURSARY

The bursary provides full residential accommodation at our annual UK conference. This includes a buffet lunch on arrival & departure, tea, coffee & biscuits, two night's bed & breakfast (Monday 4th & Tuesday 5th Aberystwyth University campus and the conference dinner. These costs are paid directly by the UK Committee and no money will be provided to the awardee. Transport costs are NOT part of this bursary.

The 2023 UK conference: This will be held at the Aberystwyth University campus on Monday 4th - Wednesday 6th September 2023. It is entitled '**Linking CE across scales (CE-to-glasshouse-to-field)**' Tour stops will include the national phenomics centre, breeding glasshouses and CE facilities at IBERS The conference dinner will be held at the Y Consti restaurant, accessible by funicular railway! The conference is fully supported by commercial manufacturers of Controlled Environments (cabinets, rooms & glasshouses) and equipment for the control and measurement of the enclosed environment. The opportunity to discuss problems and future requirements will be available throughout the conference.

The Application Form: Applicants, who are usually students, technical & support staff, (but not limited to) should provide the following information: -

Personal Details – Name, contact details & job.

Organisation Details – Name & address.

Posters have been submitted in the past but for many technical & support staff these are not a normal part of day-to-day activities. However, we are interested in what your organisation does and how you contribute to it.
